Human Rights

Specific crimes committed in the context of a large-scale attack targeting civilians, regardless of their nationality. These crimes include murder, torture, sexual violence, enslavement, persecution, enforced disappearance, etc.

A core element of the humanitarian and human rights agendas

International criminal crimes

A collective term for certain extremely serious violations of international law: genocide, war crimes, crimes against humanity, torture and enforced disappearances.

The arrest, detention, or abduction of persons by, or with the authorization, support, or acquiescence of a State or a political organization, followed by a refusal to acknowleds that deprivation of freedom, or to give information on th fate or whereabouts of those persons, with the intention of removing them from the protection of the law for a prolonged period of time.

> Rights inherent to all human beings, regardless of race, sex, nationality, ethnicity, language, religion, or any
